SUBJECT: 2013 CALIFORNIA WOMEN VETERANS SURVEY

On behalf of the California Department of Veterans Affairs (CalVet) and the California Commission on the Status of Women and Girls, the California Research Bureau (CRB) released the 2013 California Women Veterans survey on September 18, 2013. The California Women Veterans Survey is the most extensive statewide effort to gather information about women veterans and their needs. The information from this survey is used by policy makers, state agencies and service providers in California to update policies and improve services for women veterans and their families.

This year, all partners involved are asking for assistance to promote the survey and encourage women veterans to respond before the closing date in late November 2013. Therefore, all veteran representatives and partners are encouraged to help reach as many women veterans of all eras, backgrounds, and experiences as possible.
