The Employment Development Department and the [California Energy Commission \(CEC\)](#) are pleased to announce the availability of \$9 million in grants, funded through the [Electric Program Investment Charge](#). These grants are available to individuals, private entities, and public entities (except for publicly owned utilities) to provide training on the following:

- Advanced energy efficiency measures and construction practices, focusing on the proper installation of high-performance energy efficient walls and attics in new home construction projects (up to \$4.5 million).
- The installation of advanced energy efficiency measures in existing buildings located in disadvantaged communities (up to \$4.5 million).

Match funding of at least 50 percent is required for each application.

Applications must be received no later than **June 4, 2015, by 3 p.m.**
