## YOU ARE INVITED TO REGISTER FOR UI ONLINE<sup>SM</sup>

This notice is to provide you with your Employment Development Department (EDD) Customer Account Number so you can register for UI Online<sup>SM</sup>.

UI Online<sup>SM</sup> is a fast, convenient, and secure way for you to access detailed Unemployment Insurance (UI) claim and payment information, and manage your UI claim 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Now that you've filed your UI claim, you will need to provide benefit eligibility information to the EDD to receive benefit payments. This bi-weekly process is known as certifying for continued benefits. For faster benefit processing time, use UI Online<sup>SM</sup>.\*

For added convenience, UI Online Mobile<sup>SM</sup> is available for smartphone and tablet users.

To register for a UI Online<sup>SM</sup> account, visit [www.edd.ca.gov/UI\\_Online](http://www.edd.ca.gov/UI_Online). You will need your Social Security number, date of birth, personal e-mail address, and your EDD Customer Account Number below. The EDD takes the security of confidential information very seriously.
