UI OnlineSM

A **fast, convenient, and secure** way to access detailed claim and payment information, certify for benefits, and manage your UI claim online 24/7.

Why sign up for UI OnlineSM?

- **Important UI claim information is available 24/7.** Access information about your claim anywhere using your computer, smartphone, or tablet.
- **Certifications are processed faster!** On average, certifications submitted through UI OnlineSM are processed faster than by paper or phone.
- **Claimants receive fewer follow-up calls from the EDD.** With UI OnlineSM, clarifying information is obtained upfront minimizing the need for follow-up calls.
- **Updating personal information is quick and easy.** Updating a mailing address, phone number, and other information is simple and secure.
- **View all scheduled appointments and change phone interview appointments.**
- **Save money on postage and reduce common user errors that may delay benefit payments.**

Tell me more about UI OnlineSM.

UI OnlineSM is part of the EDD's ongoing efforts to improve efficiency, increase access to UI services, and expedite benefit payments to unemployed workers. With UI OnlineSM you will be able to conduct routine business from the comfort of your own home without having to wait for the mail to arrive or speaking to an EDD representative.

For added convenience, **UI Online MobileSM** is available for smartphone and tablet users.

UI OnlineSM makes it easy for you to:

- Certify for continuing benefits and report work and wages.*
- Get detailed payment and claim information.
- Reopen an existing claim to resume UI benefit payments without speaking to a representative.*
- Update contact information such as your phone number and address, quickly and easily online.

**Customers on Partial or Work Sharing claims are unable to certify for benefits or reopen an existing claim using UI OnlineSM at this time, but can access all other features of the system.*

You can also get a quick snapshot of your claim from your UI OnlineSM home page:

- Get important notifications such as when it's time to certify for benefits or reopen your claim.
- View all scheduled appointments and change a phone interview to a later date.
- See your claim summary including last payment issued, remaining balance, weekly benefit amount, and work search requirements.

What is the EDD Customer Account Number?

The EDD takes the security of confidential information very seriously and continuously looks for ways to further protect customers' personal information. In addition to the safeguards built into the EDD's systems to prevent and detect fraud, the EDD has implemented the use of the EDD Customer Account Number. This number may be used as an alternate identification number when conducting business with the EDD but will not replace a Social Security number (SSN) at this time. It is also required to register for UI OnlineSM. Remember, never share your personal information with anyone, including your EDD Customer Account Number.

What if I already have an SDI Online account from a Disability Insurance or Paid Family Leave claim?

You must use your SDI Online username and password to register for UI OnlineSM. When registering for UI OnlineSM please select the "Register Using SDI Login" button to expedite the registration process.

Register today and enjoy the many benefits and conveniences of UI OnlineSM.
