### Workforce Services Branch

- Gathers and disseminates labor market information to employers and applicants.
- Assists job seekers in meeting their employment goals or refers them to partner resources.

# Minimum Qualifications

## **EITHER I**

Four years of experience with the Employment Development Department (Candidates who are within six months of completing the required experience will be admitted to the examination; however, they must meet the required experience before being considered eligible for appointment).

## **OR II**

Completion of 60 semester units or 90 quarter units of college course work, and two years of public contact experience providing services or information.

## **OR III**

Equivalent to graduation from college (Must provide evidence of registration as a senior in a recognized institution to be admitted in the examination, and must secure evidence of graduation or its equivalent before being considered for appointment).

## How to Apply

In order to apply for an Employment Program Representative position with the State of California, you must apply, take, and be successful in the current Employment Program Representative Exam.

### **Step One – Establish Eligibility**

Visit [www.edd.ca.gov/careers](http://www.edd.ca.gov/careers) and click on the [Open Examinations](#) link. Find the Employment Program Representative bulletin and click on it. Follow the steps outlined in the bulletin to take the exam.

### **Step Two – Find Vacancies**

Visit [www.edd.ca.gov/careers](http://www.edd.ca.gov/careers) and locate the [Vacancy Search Tool](#) under the external resources section. Type "Employment Program Representative" in the search field and click search to locate vacancies.

### **Step Three – Mail in your Employment Program Representative Application Packet**

Mail in your application to the address listed on the job vacancy announcement. You should also include a résumé and cover letter with your State Application.
