



NEW REQUIRED PARTICIPANT DATA COLLECTION

The *Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act* (WIOA) requires additional participant data collection for the *Wagner-Peyser Act*, Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA), and WIOA Title 1B Adult, Dislocated Worker and Youth programs. Staff administering any of these programs are required to collect these new data elements effective July 1, 2016.

In accordance with the WIOA performance accountability requirements, CalJOBSSM was updated on July 5, 2016, to include the collection of these new data elements. These new fields are located in CalJOBS in the tab labeled "PIRL" within the Wagner-Peyser, TAA and WIOA Title IB program applications. Staff are required to complete the new "PIRL" tab for any participant enrolled into Wagner-Peyser (who receives a service other than self-service), TAA, or WIOA Title IB on, or after July 1, 2016.

Workforce Services Directive [WSD13-11](#), provides guidance regarding participant reporting requirements. All participant data, including individual applications for service, must be entered into CalJOBS within 30 days of service.
