



DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING GRANTEES FOR 2016 -17

The Employment Development Department (EDD) announces the awarding of five grants totaling \$2,225,000 for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (DHH) Program. The grants are funded by the Wagner-Peyser 10 Percent allocation. The awardees will assist DHH persons to search for and obtain unsubsidized employment through the America's Job Center of CaliforniaSM network. These awards extend DHH services to the Central Valley, and will serve DHH clients in 18 AJCC sites statewide.
